## **Release Notes For Version 7.21**

This is a special free ‘update’ install for users who have upgraded to WF/7 software version 7.2. Version 7.20 should be uninstalled first; then install 7.21. **Use of this version requires purchasing a license key to update your dongle if upgrading directly from 7.10.** (You were given this multi-digit key if you ordered 7.20 or 7.21). When you first boot WaveFrame/7 after installing this version, you may be prompted to enter this Key and Feature Number ‘29’ in the appropriate fields. Once they are entered, click OK and restart WaveFrame. If you do not yet have this key, please contact WaveFrame Software Group Sales to purchase it.

7.21 fixes a number of bugs that have been discovered in the field including:

1. Adding a “view” in the **Sound Selector** no longer crashes the system.
2. When selecting a volume under **Options**, the full name of the volume as well as the volume number is now displayed.
3. The shortcut key “ctrl+k” (allowing a toggle between “insert” and “over-write”) has been disabled to prevent accidental changes to the state of the editor.
4. A bug that was corrupting “episodic” projects has been fixed. Remember when creating a project, episode, or reel you must click on the “apply” button before the name will be added to the list.
5. The extension: **.omf** has been added to the sound preferences dialogue under the sd2 tab. Many omf projects use **.omf** to signify sd2 files. To implement, open the “sounds” menu item in **System**, open “preferences” and click on the sd2 tab. Finally, click on “factory settings”.
6. A number of significant improvements have been made to the **Volume Manager**. Various problems that related to volume mount and dismount that contained duplicate copies of the same files (UFN) have been fixed. Also, cases where deleting files (i.e. “undo” a recording) left behind bogus entries in the database, and where “aborting” a volume mount was corrupting the database have been fixed.
